<sup>9</sup>God ... is faithful to do what he says, and he has invited you into partnership with his Son, Jesus Christ our Lord."

### 1 Corinthians 1:9 NLT

God has "invited" us into partnership with Jesus! God extends an invitation to a flawed people to do the flawless work of His Son, Jesus! Doesn't make a lot of sense, but this is the Body of Christ that the world gets - an imperfect "Jesus" in a disastrous world.
