Study Notes from the Message on January 15, 2017

Romans 1:16-17 NLT

"For I am not ashamed of this Good News about Christ. It is the power of God at work, saving everyone who believes—the Jew first and also the Gentile. ¹⁷ This Good News tells us how God makes us right in his sight. This is accomplished from start to finish by faith. As the Scriptures say, 'It is through faith that a righteous person has life."

Travel is a necessity in our age of living. If we chose to do anything, be anywhere or involved in any activity, or even to succeed we must move away from our home base. Progress is defined by "move forward or onward in space or time". It's Latin origins literally means "forward; walking, or advancing" (pro-gradi). To be stagnant is not to progress.

In the adventures of travel in this century we are given many options; water, land and air. These options are all sub-divided into various categories; i.e. private, public - scenic or express. Take your pick. I've always found air travel to be especially exciting, but there is always more of a sense of anxiety than other forms of travel for me.
