We will follow strict social distancing guidelines and offer a contact free service. Older adults and those with underlying health conditions are encouraged to participate online. If you or anyone in your household is ill, please worship at home until feeling better.

Social Distancing & PPE

- ◆ Masks are required, gloves are optional. We will provide masks and gloves or you can use your own mask.
- ◆ Hand sanitizer stations will be available
- ◆ Enter through Door 1 or Door 4 (door 4 is handicap accessible). Each person's temperature will be taken with a contact-free thermometer.
- ◆ Areas of ministry facility will be restricted
- ◆ Ushers will seat individuals & families to ensure safe distancing in the Worship Center. Ushers will also dismiss individuals and families one at a time.
- ◆ High touchpoint surfaces will be cleaned throughout the service

Contact Free Service

- ◆ Doors will be propped open
- ◆ No handshakes, high fives, fist bumps, hugs, or handouts
- ◆ Bring your own coffee
- ◆ Giving box and online giving available (no collection plates will be passed)
- ◆ Communion on first Sunday of the month will be contactless as well

Church Programming

- ◆ We will sing songs of praise using pre-recorded music by our worship team
- ◆ We will not have any youth or children's classes on Sunday mornings (until further notice), so families will worship together in the Worship Center or can continue to use the at-home worship experience online.
